The Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas has received and examined your grievance against the above-named individual. When a grievance is received, this office conducts an initial review to determine whether the alleged conduct would be a violation of the ethics rules. If the conduct does not allege a violation, the grievance is classified as an Inquiry and dismissed with a right to appeal the dismissal. If the conduct alleges a violation, the grievance is classified as a Complaint and investigated. We have determined that the conduct as described in your grievance involved actions taken by that person in their capacity as a judge. Therefore, your grievance has been classified as an Inquiry and dismissed pursuant to rule 2.10 of the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure (TRDP).
