- 7 2. All discovery or discovery-related motion practice is STAYED until
8 November 16, 2007.
- 9 3. Defendant Briggs shall not have to provide Initial Disclosures or participate in
10 a Joint Status report until after her motion for summary judgment is decided. If
11 her summary judgment motion is denied, a new date will be provided.
